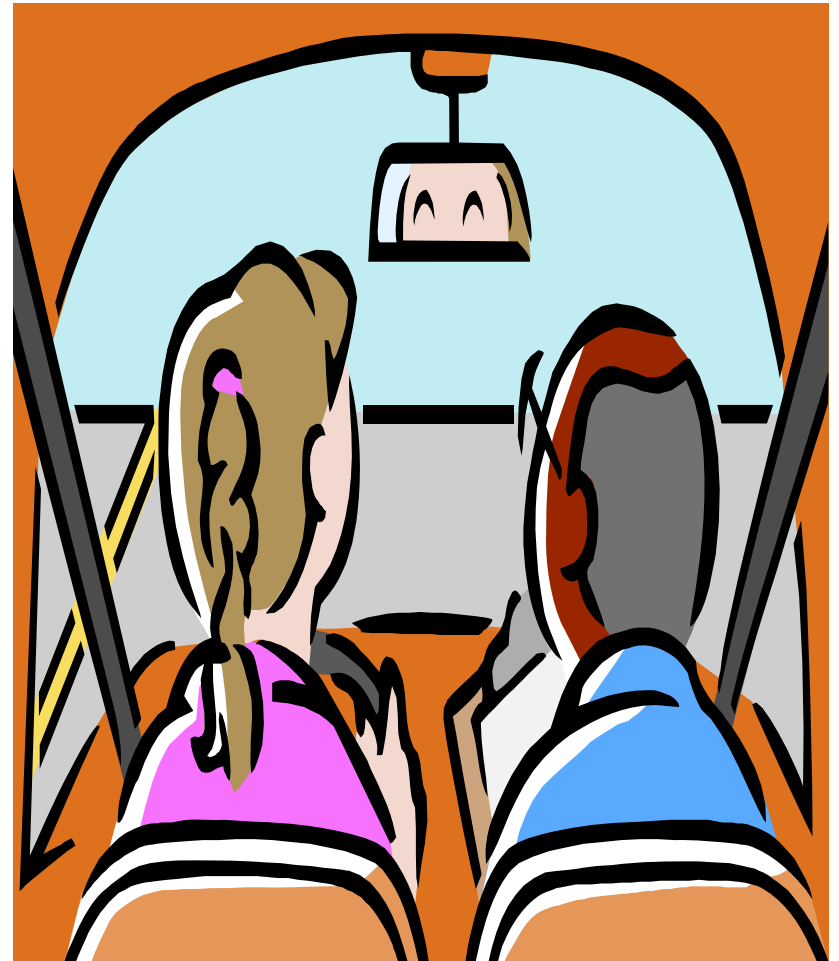
# CHESAPEAKE 'S DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAM

- Approved by the Virginia Department of Education.
- Two-phase program

Part I - Theory/Classroom  
36 Hours

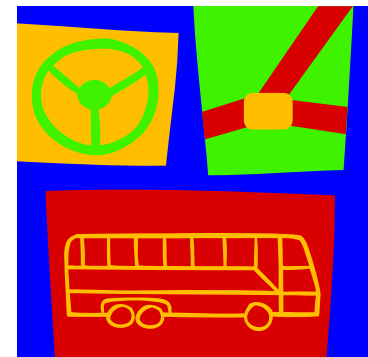
Part II - In –car Instruction

- A. Simulator – 7 hours
- B. Range - 7 hours
- C. Road test - 4 to 5 class periods



# Scheduling Students in Driver Education

- Students are schedule into tenth grade physical education according to date-of –birth.
- Older students are schedule in the fall term.
- Younger students are schedule in the spring term.
- Two weeks PE (BTW) and two weeks theory/health.



# EVALUATION POLICY



- THE STUDENT'S GRADES ARE COMBINED WITH THEIR P.E. GRADE 50% OF THE TOTAL GRADE THAT APPEARS ON THE REPORT CARD.



# EVAULATION POLICY

- **PREPARATION: 30%**

# THE JUVENILE LICENSING PROCESS

- A JUVENILE MAY APPLY FOR A LEARNER'S PERMIT IF HE OR SHE IS AT LEAST **15 YEARS AND SIX MONTHS OF AGE.**
- A JUVENILE WHO FAILS THE DMV KNOWLEDGE TEST **THREE TIMES** MUST COMPLETE A CLASSROOM DRIVER EDUCATION COURSE BEFORE BEING ELIGIBLE TO TAKE THE TEST A **FOURTH TIME.**





- A JUVENILE MAY APPLY FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE WHEN HE OR SHE BECOMES 16 YEARS AND THREE MONTHS.
- A JUVENILE MUST HOLD A LEARNER'S PERMIT FOR NINE MONTHS, OR UNTIL THE LEARNER'S PERMIT HOLDER TURNS 19 (WHICHEVER COMES FIRST).

- STUDENTS YOUNGER THAN 18 MUST HAVE THEIR PARENTS, FOSTER PARENTS, OR GUARDIAN CERTIFY THAT THEY HAVE ***DRIVEN A MOTOR VEHICLE FOR AT LEAST 45 HOURS, AT LEAST 15 OF WHICH WERE AFTER SUNSET.***



- STUDENTS YOUNGER THAN 19 MUST SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE A STATE-APPROVED DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAM.
- THE IN-CAR TEACHER WILL ADMINISTER THE ROAD TEST. IF YOUR CHILD SUCCESSFULLY PASSES THE TEST, MEETS ALL THE LICENSING REQUIREMENTS, AND THE SCHOOL RECEIVES WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE PARENTS TO LICENSE THE CHILD, THE SCHOOL WILL ISSUSE THE STUDENT A 180-DAY TEMPORARY PROVISIONAL DRIVER'S LICENCE.



# LEARNER'S PERMIT AND PROVISIONAL DRIVER'S LICENSE RESTRICTIONS

- PROHIBITS DRIVING WITH **MORE THAN ONE NON-FAMILY PASSENGER LESS THAN 18 YEARS OLD** UNTIL THE HOLDER HAS HELD A PROVISIONAL LICENSE FOR ONE YEAR, AND NO MORE THAN THREE NON-FAMILY PASSENGERS LESS THAN 18 YEARS OLD UNTIL AGE 18.

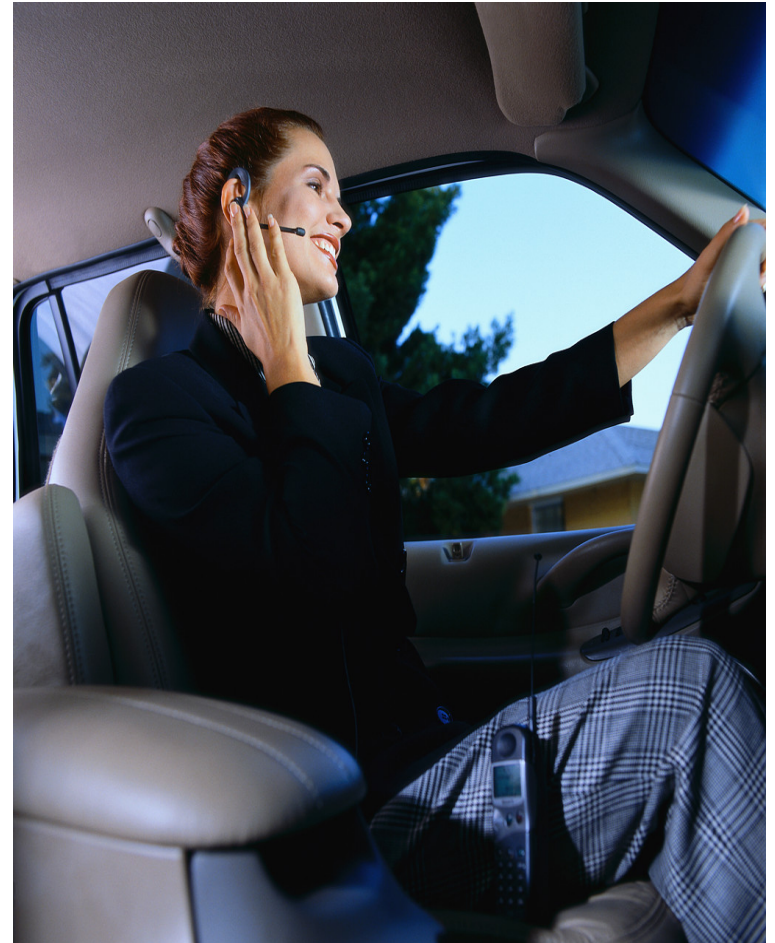




- RESTRICTS LICENSED DRIVERS YOUNGER THAN 18 YEARS OLD FROM OPERATING A VEHICLE BETWEEN MIDNIGHT AND 4 A.M., EXCEPT WHEN DRIVING
- 1. TO AND FROM WORK;
- 2. TO AND FROM A SCHOOL- SPONSORED ACTIVITY;
- 3. WHEN ACCOMPAINED BY A PARENT OR PERSON IN LOCO PARENTIS, OR BY A SPOUSE WHO IS 18 YEARS OLD OR OLDER;
- 4. IN CASES OF EMERGENCY; OR
- 5. WHEN RESPONDING TO FIRE OR SOME OTHER EMERGENCY AS A VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER OR RESCUE WORKER.

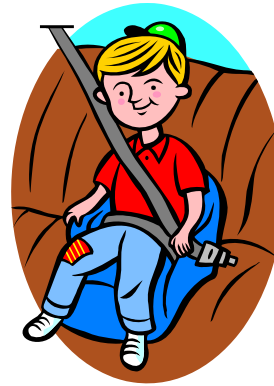
# RESTRICTIONS

- PROHIBITS DRIVERS UNDER 18 FROM USING CELL PHONES OR WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICES WHILE DRIVING, REGARDLESS OF HAND-HELD OR HANDS-FREE, EXCEPT IN A DRIVER EMERGENCY AND VEHICLE IS LAWFULLY PARKED OR STOPPED.



# RESTRICTIONS

- REQUIRES DRIVERS YOUNGER THAN 18 YEARS OF AGE WHO ARE OCCUPYING THE REAR SEATS OF A VEHICLE TO USE SAFTEY BELTS.



# RESTRICTIONS

- REQUIRES DRIVERS YOUNGER THAN 20 YEARS OF AGE TO ATTEND A DRIVER IMPROVEMENT CLINIC IF CONVICTED OF A DERMERIT POINT OFFENSE ( MOVING VIOLATION), A SEAT BELT OR CHILD SAFETY SEAT VIOLATION.



# THE PARENTS' ROLE IN THE JUVENILE LICENSING PROCESS

- THE FAMILY, NOT THE SCHOOL, IS IN THE BEST POSITION TO HAVE A SUSTAINED EFFECT ON MINIMIZING RISKS FACED BY INEXPERIENCED DRIVERS AND ENCOURAGING RESPONSIBLE BEHAVIOR.



# PARENTS MUST:



- GRANT THE DMV PERMISSION TO ISSUE THEIR CHILD A LEARNER'S PERMIT AND A DRIVERS LICENSE.
- GRANT THE SCHOOL PERMISSION TO ENROLL THEIR CHILD IN THE IN-CAR PHASE OF DRIVER EDUCATION.

Chesapeake Public School Fee \$200.00 must be paid before a 180- Day Temporary License is issue.

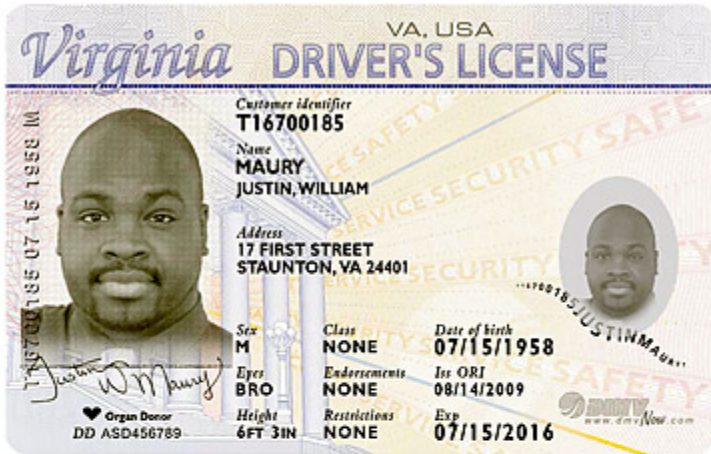
# PARENTS MUST:



- PROVIDE THEIR CHILD WITH AT LEAST 45 HOURS OF GUIDED PRACTICE, 15 OF WHICH MUST BE AFTER SUNSET.
- DETERMINE WHEN THEIR CHILD IS READY TO DRIVE UNCHAPERONED.

# PARENTS MUST:

- SUSPEND THE MINOR CHILD'S DRIVING PRIVILEGES IF HE OR SHE IS NOT DEMONSTRATING RESPONSIBLE BEHAVIOR.



# PARENT'S MUST:

- NOTIFY THEIR INSURANCE AGENT WHEN THEIR CHILD RECEIVES A 180-DAY TEMPORARY PROVISIONAL DRIVER'S LICENSE.



# PARENTS MUST:

- CONTINUE TO MONITOR THEIR CHILD'S DRIVING AFTER RECEIPT OF A PROVISIONAL LICENSE AND REINFORCE SAFETY BELT USE, LIMIT PASSENGERS, AND OTHER DRIVING DISTRACTIONS.



# PARENTS MUST:

- ESTABLISH ZERO TOLERANCE RULES FOR CELL PHONE AND TEXT MESSAGING WHILE DRIVING.



# PARENTS MUST: MODEL SAFE DRIVING BEHAVIORS
